 Name, and for my use, to ask, Demand and receive of and
 from the Honourable the Controller General of the State of
 Pennsylvania; My Deed or Grant the tract of Land which to
 me is allotted for my service in the Pennsylvania Troops during
 the last and glorious War; giving and hereby granting unto
 the said Attorney, full and whole Power, to take, pursue, and follow
 such legal wayes and courses, for the recovery, receiving and obtaining
 and Discharging upon the said Land which is allotted to me
 for my said service in the Pennsylvania troops during the last
 War, as I myself might or could do ~~if~~ personally present:
 and I do hereby ratify, allow and confirm all and whatever my
 Attorney shall lawfully do, or cause to be Done, in and about the
 Execution of the tract of Land for recovering the said Lot of Land
 as to me allotted for my above mentioned service in the Penn-
 sylvania Troops, by virtue of this presents. In Witness Whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty fourth Day of
 August in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and
 Eighty seven.
