my Discharge) I do by these Presents constitute and appoint  
and in my stead and place put my trusty friend Samuel  
Quigley of Cumberland County State aforesaid My true and  
Lawfull Attorney to Ask Demand Recover Receive for me and  
in my name A Deed or patent for two Hundred Acres of  
Land Due unto me from the State of Pennsylvania upon the  
Account of me being a Soldier during the late War, and  
further to do Execute Perform and finish for me and in my  
name ~~any~~ thing or things as fully and Entirely as I the said  
Jacob Justice could in or concerning the same. Ratifying con-  
firming and Allowing whatsoever my D. Attorney shall so do  
or Cause to be Done in Witness Whereof I the said Jacob  
Justice have hereunto set my hand and Seal this seventh  
Day of April one thousand seven Hundred and eighty eight
