Calculation and Reckoning of your Administration, upon your solemn Oath to
render at or before the Twenty eight day of December in the Year of our Lord
One thousand seven hundred and eighty four or when Legally thereunto
required, And I do by these presents, Ordain, Constitute and depute you the said
Christian Storm — Administrator of all and singular the goods and
Chattels rights & Credits which were of the said Deceased, within the limits
aforesaid, saving harmless & forever indemnifying me, & all other officers
Against all persons, by reason of your Administration afores^d & saving all
Others their rights &c.
