one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine, personally
appeared before me Samuel Powell Esquire, Mayor of the said
City, Timothy Lane who being duly sworn on the Holy Gospels
of Almighty God did declare, that he enlisted in the armies
of the United States in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
and seventy six, that he continued to serve in the said
armies until the thirtieth day of September 1783,
when he was regularly discharged at Pittsburg by General
William Suwin, that he has not sold his donation
Land to any person or persons whatsoever, and that
he left his discharge in the care of Peter Neufelman
of Lancaster County
