Beth Remembered that on the Sixth Day of March in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and four, Before me the Subscriber one of the Associate Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County aforesaid, personally appeared Christian Nagel of Hopewell Township in the County of Bedford, who being duly sworn upon the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God did depose and say That he is, for these many years past, well and intimately acquainted with Ezekiel Sankey, and that to this DepONENTS certain Knowledge the said Ezekiel Sankey served as a private Soldier in Captain John Christy's Company of the third Pennsylvania Regiment commanded by Colonel Richard Butler in the Service of the United States during the late Revolutionary War, and that he was enlisted for and continued in the service aforesaid during and until the End of the said War, and that he obtained his Discharge from the Service on or about the 19th Day of June 1783.

And this DepONENT further saith that there was no other Person of the Name of Ezekiel Sankey but the above

named Ezekiel Sankey in the Regiment aforesaid, and that the present aforesaid Ezekiel Sankey, is the same identified person mentioned in the above deposition And further this DepONENT saith not
