 the Only proper use and behoof of the Said Stephen London
 His Heirs and Assigns for ever. Defending the Said
 tract of Land and Appurtenances unto the Said Stephen
 London his heirs and Assigns Against every person or persons
 Lawfully Claiming or to Claim from by under me. In
