

to make <sup>all</sup> my name seal and deliver. And generally and every other act or Act. being things device & devices. in the Law whatsoever needful and necessary to be done in and about the premises, for the recovery of all or any such debt or sum of money special, for me and in my name to do execute and perform as fully, largely, and amply, to all intents & purposes as if myself might or could do if I were personally present. or as if the matter required more special authority than is here in given, and attorney's one or more under him for the purposes aforesaid. to make and constitute and again at pleasure to revoke, ratifying allowing and holding him and effectual all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do in and about the premises by virtue hereof.
