


Know all men by these presents That I Samuel Marshall formerly

 Rights Title and Interest Use Profession Property Claim Demand whatsoever  
 which I now have or which my Heirs Executors or Administrators may at  
 any time hereafter have to all and singular the Lands Pay Arrearages of  
 Pay to Clothing Rations Gratuities or other demands due or owing to me from  
 the United States or from any particular State for my services as aforesaid  
 To have & to hold all and singular the above mentioned and assigned  
 Premises with the Appurtenances unto him the said Christian Hubbert  
 his Heirs and Assigns to the only proper use benefit and behoof of him the  
 said Christian Hubbert his Heirs and Assigns forever and do hereby  
 nominate constitute and appoint him the said Christian Hubbert his
