 or warrants for all that quantity of land to which my
 late Husband Geo. Martin was entitled as a Soldier in
 the Line a Soldier of the late Army together with such Dues
 or Dues as are usually given in such cases; and also to
 receive from the War Office a warrant for such Land
 as my late Husband was entitled to from Congress as
 a Continental Soldier enlisted during the War of
 Independence and hereby empower my said Attorney to perform
 if necessary and in general to transact every thing relating
 to the Premises as fully as if I was personally present
 given under my Hand and Seal this Twentieth second Day
 of November 1791.
