Atty. by these presents my full power and Authority in and about the
Premises and upon the Receipt of any such Arrears of Pay
Gratuity or Deed aforesaid Acquittance or other sufficient discharge
for me and in my Name and Generally all and every other
thing that and that thing things Devise or Devices in the Law
Whosoever needfull of my to be Done in and about the Premises
for me and in my Name to do and execute and perform as fully
Solely and amply to all Intents and purposes as I might or
could do if I was personally present —

my said Atty. shall Lawfully do in and about the Premises by his
