 & things whatsoever, needfull & necessary to be done in and about  
 the premises, as fully, largely and amply, to all intents and  
 purposes, as we ourselves might or could do, if personally  
 Present at the doing thereof, and Attorneys one or more unde-  
 sign for the purpose aforesaid to make & constitute, & again  
 at pleasure to revoke, hereby ratifying, allowing & holding  
 for firm & good, all & whatever our said Attorney shall  
 Lawfully do in & about the premises by Virtue hereof, in Witness  
 Whereof We have hereunto set our hands & Seals this 22<sup>d</sup> day of  
 February 1803.
