Administration, and a final Disposition from the same to me is
manifestly known to belong I deeming that the goods Charles Wrights
and Credits of the said deceased may be well and truly administered,
do hereby grant unto you the said Alexander M. Hinky in whose
Fidelity in this Behalf I Very much confide, full power by the
Tenor of these presents, to administer the goods, Charles, Wrights and
Credits which were of the said deceased within the said County
and also to settle, collect, levy, recover and receive the debts and Credits
over of the said deceased, which at the time of his death were
owing or to him due in any ways belong and to pay the Debts in which
the said deceased stood Obligated so far forth as the goods, Charles
Rights, and Credits will Extend according to their State and
Order of Law especially of well and truly administering the goods
Rights and Credits of the said deceased and Making and perfecting
Inventory thereof and exhibiting the same into the Register's Office
at the Town of Reading in the County of Berks, or before the
next Court day of January next and under a true and just
Account Calculation or Reckoning of the said Administration
at or before the seven tenth day of December in the year of
our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Ninety two
And also I do by these presents obtain constitute and
appoint you the said Alexander M. Hinky Administrator
of all and singular the goods Charles Wrights and Credits
