

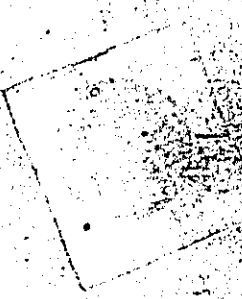
K NOW ALL MEN By these Presents that *John M. Kenley*

well and truly paid by *Simon Rigby* of the County
of Bucks before the sealing and delivery hereof; the receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge, have and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell, assign, re-
lease, and confirm, unto the said *Simon Rigby* and to
his heirs and assigns, forever; all my estate, right, title, interest, use, possession, proper claim,
and demand, whatever, which I now have to all and singular the lands, pay, arrearages of pay,
Clothing, Rations, gratuities or other demands, due and owing to me from the United States,
or from any particular State, for my Services as aforesaid. To have and to hold, all and singular

the above mentioned and assigned premises, with the appurtenances, unto him the said
Simon Rigby his heirs and assigns forever; and
do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint him the said *Simon*
Rigby his heirs and assigns, my true and lawful attorney,
irrevocably to ask, demand, recover, and receive of and from the United States, or from any
particular State whatsoever, or from any person or persons acting by, from, or under their or
any of theirs authority, all and singular the said lands, pay, arrearages of pay, rations, Gra-
tuities, and other demands, whatsoever due and owing to me as aforesaid; and to receive and accept
the same by grant or otherwise, in his or their own names, and to his or their own proper use and
 behoof forever; and also to sign seal and execute good and sufficient discharge for the same, in
due form of Law. In witness whereof *I* have hereunto set my hand and
