in and for said County came John Jordan Esquire
being Sworn according to Law did depose and say
that some short time before Hugh Melholam left
this part of the County he depont. heard the said
Hugh Melholam Acknowledge that Edward Omeal
in his lifetime had Lodged in his hand a Patent
for Two Hundred Acres of donation Land which he
Omeal had received from the State of Pennsylvania for
his services as a Soldier, and said that the said Edw.
Omeal was ~~entitled~~ ^{indebted} to him a certain sum of money
and that he would not deliver the said Patent to
the widow of the said Edw. or any other person until
he was paid, depont. does not recollect the exact sum but
thinks it was about four Pounds - Melholam Acknow-
-ledged at the same time that he had never got any
Transfer on said Patent from said Omeal
