a certain tract of Land in one of the Townships
Districts in the County of Westmoreland containing
Two Hundred & fifty Acres of Allowance of Six P.
Cent for Taxes due in District N^o 7
and Loc. N^o 143 and I do desire that the
patent may issue in the name of the property of
Jos. Johnston his heirs & assigns for ever, And I
do by these presents warrant & defend it from any
heirs & assigns for ever all & every other persons
lawfully claiming from by or under me,
as Witness my hand & seal this 16th day
