well and truly paid by *John Shaw* of the State of
Pennsylvania before the sealing and delivery hereof; the Receipt whereof

I do hereby acknowledge, have and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell, assign, re-
lease, and confirm, unto the said *John Shaw* and to
his heirs and assigns, forever; all my estate, right, title, interest, use, possession, proper claim,
and demand, whatever, which I now have to all and singular the lands, pay, arrearages of pay,
Clothing, Rations, gratuities or other demands, due and owing to me from the United States,
or from any particular State, for my Services as aforesaid. To have and to hold, all and singular

the above mentioned and assigned premises, with the appurtenances, unto him the said *John*
Shaw his heirs and assigns forever; and
do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint him the said *John Shaw*
his heirs and assigns, my true and lawful attorney,

irrevocably, to ask, demand, recover and receive of and from the United States, or from any
particular State whatsoever, or from any person or persons acting by, from, or under their or
any of their authority, all and singular the said lands, pay, arrearages of pay, rations, Gra-
tuities, and other demands, whatsoever due and owing to me as aforesaid; and to receive and accept
the same by grant or otherwise, in his or their own names, and to his or their own proper use and
behoof forever; and also to sign seal and execute good and sufficient discharge for the same, in

or Means whatsoever by

The United States for my services
rendered as a soldier in the *Regiments* aforesaid
also to receive any land that may be due
me from the *United States* or State of
Pennsylvania

giving and granting unto *my* said Attorney, by these Presents,
full and whole Powers, Strength and Authority, in and about the Premises,
to have, use and take, all lawful Ways and Means in *my* Name for the
Recovery thereof, and upon the Receipt of any such Debts, Dues or Sums
of Money aforesaid, Acquittances, or other sufficient Discharges, for *me*
and in *my* Name, to make, seal, and deliver, and generally all and every
other Act and Acts, Thing and Things, Device or Devices, in the Law,
whatsoever, needful and necessary to be done in and about the Premises, for
me and in *my* Name to do, exe-
cute and perform, as fully, largely and amply, to all Intents and Purposes,
as *I* might or could do, if *I* was personally present,
or as if the Matter required more especial authority than is herein given;
and Attorneys one or more under *him* for the Purpose aforesaid,
to make and constitute, and again at pleasure to revoke; ratifying, allowing
and holding, for firm and effectual, all and whatsoever *my* said At-
torney shall lawfully do in and about the Premises, by Virtue hereof. In
