a Powers of Attorney to one Anthony Muckemuck one to a John Blane  
also one to a Man by the Name of Mouse but that he never got a thing  
from either but that he always promised him Payment untill the  
had the Powers executed and then denied Payment untill they would get  
the land and that he never could get the Powers out of their hands and that  
they knew him to be a poor fellow that could not stand the law with them  
this Deponent further says that he knew Miller when he acted as a  
Quarter Master Sergeant in Captain Vanhairs troop of horse further  
this Deponent doth not
