Know all Men by these presents, that I Ebenezer
Thompson of the State of New York, late of Pennsylvania,
for and in Consideration of divers good Causes done, do
hereby Nominate, Constitute and appoint, my trusty friend
Robert Sheparde, to receive all my pay, and Arrears of pay,
my Lands, and every emolument appertaining or coming,
or any ways belonging to me, from the State of Pennsylvania
for my Services done as a Dragoon in Colonel Stephen
Moylands Regiment of Cavalry. - And further do, by
these presents, Grant, Bargain, and Sell the above
mentioned Lands, and pay to the said Robert Shepard

his Heirs and Assigns for ever, for the Consideration
of Thirty pounds Specie, receiv'd of him in August
1783. I hereby do empower any Attorney to
act for him in my behalf, in receiving or recovering
the said Lands and Monies, equally the same as if
I was then and there ^{myself} present in person; and his receipts
shall stand as that of my own. - Given under my

Hand and Seal this 23. day of June 1787. ~
