of this Transitory Life Do Make and Declare that I intend
to Contain my last Will and Testament that is to say I give
and Bequeath unto John Ballou of the City aforesaid Porter
All & Every Sum or Sums of Money Land &c that is or shall
be Coming to me from the State of Pennsylvania or any of
the United States of America for my Services in the Army
of the said States. And all the Rest of my Estate Real Personal
Wherewith at the Time of my Decease shall be Possess'd or
Invested or whiche shall belong or of Right Appertain unto
me to give Devise and Bequeath unto the said John Ballou

And I Do hereby Nominate and Appoint John Ballou
of the City aforesaid Porter to be my sole Executor of
my last Will & Testament hereby Revoking all former
Wills & Testaments by me made and Do Declare this to
be my Last In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set
my hand & Seal this 12th Day of May Annoque
Domini 1786.
