This 18th day of January 1863 I, Frederick W. Waddle
hundred of acres, on oath before me the subscriber
one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas
in and for said county, who saith, that Christian
Waddle enlisted as a Soldier in the Continental
Army during the Revolutionary War, in Capt.
Charles Craig's troop of Light Dragoons,
and was regularly discharged at the
conclusion of said War, & that the said
Christian Waddle now applying for his
donation land is the same Christian
Waddle above described.
