 under Capt Shrader in the late war with Britain as in
 and by the said Letter of Attorney will more fully appear
 Now know ye that I the said Adam Necker for divers
 good Causes & Consideration me therunto specially moving
 have Constituted and appointed Christian Greff of the County
 of Mountgommery my true and Lawfull Attorney under
 me and in my name and stead and for ^{and in his own name} the sole use
 and benefit for him the said Greff all such Lands which
 the said John Weis is or may be entitled to in Consideration
 for his Services rendered as a Soldier in the late war with
 Britain Giving and Granting unto my said Attorney with
 full power and Authority as I my self have to do in
 and about the Premises were I personally present and
 Attorney, one or more under him for the purpose aforesaid
 hereby Ratifying and Confirming whatsoever my said Attorney
 shall Lawfully do about the premises. In Witness Whereof

 of February One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety
