

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT, I,

James Williams, of the County of Berkeley, State of North-Carolina, do hereby certify, that I have been commanded by the President of the United States, to raise a Regiment of North-Carolina, to be in the Service of the United States, and by these Presents do make, ordain and constitute, and in my Place and Stead, to and deputy, my true and lawful Attorney, irrevocable for me, and in my Name and Stead, but to the sole Use of him the said Attorney, to receive all such Sum or Sums of Money, as he shall demand, and by all lawful Means recover and receive, and to assign for ever; to well as Grants or Confirmations, Lands and Tenements, or other Demands whatsoever by the United States, or the State of North-Carolina, or any other Person or Persons acting under their Authority; and I also give and grant unto my said Attorney full Power and absolute Authority, to sell and dispose of all and singular the Lands, Tenements, Gratuities and Donations, which I may be entitled to, or of Right may claim, in Virtue of any Act of the United States, or by Reason of my having served in the said Army, or in any Regiment of the said Army, or in any Line, and by good and sufficient Assurances in the Law, to grant, convey and confirm, to the Purchaser or Purchasers, the Fee simple and Inheritance thereof, he or they coming unto my said Attorney, fully, lawfully, and in good Faith, and Authority to appoint one or more Attorneys under him or them, for the Purpose aforesaid; ratifying and confirming all and singular whatsoever my said Attorneys shall or may do in the Premises, by Virtue hereof. In WITNESS whereof, I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal, this 27th Day of August, 1791, and in the Year of our LORD, One thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety One.
