And I do said George without cost for myself, my heirs, Executors and administrators, do covenant, promise and agree with the said Abraham Bell his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, that I will not revoke or annul the Power of attorney herein contained; or do any act, which shall impede the said Abraham Bell in exhibiting or obtaining a grant or grants patent or patents for the said inventions of George without consent
