This Indenture made and concluded
 the eighth day of January One thousand seven
 hundred and eighty seven Between Christian
 Maple, sergeant in the late Army of the United
 States of the one part And Francis Murray
 of the County of Bucks in the State of Penn-
 sylvania, Esquire of the other Part Witnesseth
 that the said Christian Maple for and in
 Consideration of the sum of Twenty Pounds
 to him in hand paid by the said Francis
 Murray and for other valuable Considerations
 doth by these presents grant bargain sell release
 and confirm unto the said Francis Murray
 his heirs and assigns for ever A Certain
 tract of Land in one of the Donation Districts
 in the County of Westmoreland containing
 Two Hundred and fifty Acres and all orance
 of six Feet for roads & in District N^o 10
 and lot N^o 204 And I do desire that the
 Patent may issue in my Name and as the
 property of said Francis Murray his heirs
 and assigns for ever And I do by these presents
 Warrant and defend it from me my heirs and
 assigns forever and from all and every other
 person and persons whatsoever lawfully claiming
 or to claim by from or under me. In Witness
