I know all Men by these presents that I John
 Woodden in the fourth Pennsylvania Reg of Artillery
 a private for the sum of five Shillings specie in hand
 paid by Joseph Scatter of the City of Philadelphia do
 Sell and assign and set over to the said Joseph Scatter
 his heirs and assigns all my Right claim and
 demand of or to the two Hundred Acres
 of Land given or promised to me for my services
 in the Pennsylvania Line of the Army - And I
 hereby constitute him the said Joseph Scatter
 my lawfull attorney to Draw receive and Receipt
 for the same and act and do for me and in my
 name as fully as I could or would do if I was per-
 sonally present Witness my hand and seal
 this 25th day of June in the year 1792
