

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John Andrew* in the late army of the *United States*

Andrew Private

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *John Andrew* a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at an Elm Tree and running East by Lot N^o 2121 two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugar Tree, thence South by Lot N^o 2140 one hundred and thirty perches to an Elm Tree, thence West by Lot N^o 2126 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Black Oak, thence North by Lot N^o 2112 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning containing Two hundred Acres and allowance of Six p Cent for Roads &c. Numbered MMCXXV.

with its appurtenances unto the said *John Andrew* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John Andrew* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

John Andrew his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth

part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges.

the state seal to be affixed the *twenty first* day of *February* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty *seven* and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
