KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by Daniel Broadhead Colonel

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said Daniel Broadhead a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland and in the 10th District of donation Lands Beginning at a Sugar Tree Running North by Lot N^o. 193 two hundred and sixty one perches to an Ash Tree thence East by Lot N^o. 195 three hundred and twenty five perches to an Iron Wood Tree thence South by Lot N^o. 99 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar Tree thence West by Lot N^o. 197 three hundred and twenty five perches to the place of beginning. Containing Five hundred Acres and allowance of Six ⁷/₈ Cent for Roads. Numbered CXCVI.

with its appurtenances unto the said Daniel Broadhead his heirs and assigns forever: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Daniel Broadhead his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said Daniel Broadhead his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges.
