KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by Samuel

in the late army of the United States

by Lot N^o 2640 one hundred and thirty perches to a Beech tree thence West by Lot N^o 2030 two hun-
dred and sixty one perches to a Beech tree thence e North by Lot N^o 95 one hundred and thirty
perches to a Beech tree the place of Beginning containing Two hundred acres and all the
of six per cent for Roads &cⁿ Numbered 2029

with its appurtenances, unto the said Samuel Crawford — his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said Samuel Crawford — his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
