To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

Private

That in consideration of the services rendered by *William Clarke*

in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *William Clarke*
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

*In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a sugar Tree the numbered corner and running
East by Lot N^o 2087 two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugar Tree, thence South by Lot N^o 2095 one
hundred and thirty perches to a Beech Tree, thence West by Lot N^o 2085 two hundred and sixty
one perches to a Beech Tree, thence North by Lot N^o 2053 one hundred and thirty perches to
the place of beginning Containing Two hundred Acres & allowance of half an acre for roads & Numbered
MM LXXXVII.*

with its appurtenances unto the said *William Clarke* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said *William Clarke* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

William Clarke his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle*

Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the state seal to be affixed the *thirtieth* day of *March* in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*.
