KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by Christian

Brow private

in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto John Nicholson A signee
of the said Christian Brow, a certain tract or parcel of Land, lying in the county of Allegany
In the tenth district of Donation Lands Beginning at an Iron wood tree the Numbered
corner an running East by lot N^o 2051 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Birch tree thence
South by lot N^o 2087 one hundred and thirty perches to a Sugar tree thence West by lot N^o 2053 two
hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech tree thence North by lot N^o 2045 one hundred and thirty
perches to an Iron wood tree the place of Beginning containing Two hundred acres of Land and
~~allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Numbered 2052~~

~~with its appurtenances unto the said John Nicholson~~ his heirs and assigns forever:
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said John Nicholson his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

John e Nicholson his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof His Excellency Thomas Mifflin
Esquire, President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the State seal to be affixed the first day of July in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty Nine and of the Commonwealth the Thirteenth
