North one hundred thirty perches to a white oak, thence by lot No. 255 West two hundred sixty one perches to

by lot No. 273 South one hundred thirty perches to a Post, and thence by lot No. 257 East two hundred sixty

Beginning containing Two hundred Acres and Allowance of six p. Cent for roads &c. Which said

in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly passed the 21<sup>th</sup> February 1785.

To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said John Evans and his Heirs to the use of

his Heirs and Assigns for ever.

free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to Mines, Royalties, Quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving Silver Ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth, clear of all charges. In Testimony whereof, I have set my Hand, and caused the Great
