To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

**KNOW YE,**

Hackett Private

That in consideration of the services rendered by Nicholas

in the late army of the United States —

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said Nicholas Hackett

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland

In the fifth district of donation Lands beginning at a Stake the Numbered Corner  
and running East by lot N<sup>o</sup> 1274 one hundred and thirty perches to a Stake thence  
South by lot N<sup>o</sup> 1273 two hundred and sixty one perches to a White Oak thence West  
of this for William Stemons by Vacant Land one hundred and thirty perches to a White Thorn Northly lot  
N<sup>o</sup> 1276 two hundred and sixty one perches to the place of beginning Containing  
Two hundred acres and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads & Bridges

David Acheyon Two hundred acres and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads & Bridges  
MCCCLXXVII  
with its appurtenances unto the said Nicholas Hackett his heirs and assigns forever  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances hereof, unto the  
said Nicholas Hackett his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said  
Nicholas Hackett his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth  
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof The Honorable Charles C. Collier  
Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused  
the state seal to be affixed the sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the sixteenth
