

Now ye, That in consideration of the services rendered by Cornelius Huffman private — in the late Army of the United
Pennsylvania since — there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto the said Cornelius Huffman a certain Tract of land No.
Situé in Donations District N^o. 2, in Butler County Beginning at a Post thence by N^o. 220 East two hun-
perches to a black Oak, thence by N^o. 221 South one hundred thirty perches to a Sassafras tree thence by N^o. 222 West by
one perches to a white Oak, and thence by N^o. 233 North one hundred thirty perches to the Beginning, Containing 3
Acres, and allowance of six ft. Cent for roads &c. / Which said Tract was surveyed in pursuance of an Ac-
Assembly passed 24th February 1785. /

To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Cornelius Huffman and his Heirs to the use of him the said
his Heirs and Assigns forever.

Silver Ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the Pitt's mouth, clear of all charges. In Testimony whereof, I have set my Hand, and caused the Great Seal of the
Presents, at Lancaster this second day of March — in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty — and of the Commonwealth the twenty-seventh.
