To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

KNOW YE,

David Jones Chaplain

That in consideration of the services rendered by *the Reverend*

in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *David Jones*
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

*in the tenth District of Colonization of Lands Beginning at a Sugar tree numbered corner, running
East by Lot N° 142 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar, thence South by Lot N° 202 One
hundred & Ninety five perches to a Beech, thence West by Lot N° 146 Two hundred and sixty one perches
to a Sugar, thence North by Lot N° 142 One hundred and Ninety five perches to the place of Beginning
containing Three hundred Acres of allowance of six feet and for roads &c Numbered XCVII*

Donation Land

with its appurtenances unto the said *David Jones* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the

said *David Jones* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

David Jones his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clerk of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Beale*

the state seal to be affixed the *twelfth* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty *and* of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
