

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

Johnston Colonel

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Francis*

in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *Francis Johnston*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

and in the 10th District of donation Lands Beginning at a Sugar Tree and running
North by Lot No. 184 two hundred and fifty one perches to a Sugar Tree whence East by Lot
No. 192 three hundred and twenty five perches to a Sugar Tree whence South by Lot No. 193 two
hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree whence West by Lot No. 190 three hundred and
twenty five perches to the place of beginning. Containing Five hundred acres and allowing
one acre for Roads & Numbered CXXI including part of the Head Waters of
French Creek

with its appurtenances unto the said *Francis Johnston*

his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said *Francis Johnston*

his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Francis Johnston his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle*

Esquire, *the President of the Supreme Executive Council*, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the state seal to be affixed the *Eleventh* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty six and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
