To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

**KNOW YE,**

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John McKenn*  
*Kenn Soldier* in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *John McKenn*  
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

~~John McKenn~~ in the tenth District of Donation Lands, Beginning at a Beech the numbered Corner  
running East by vacant Land Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar, thence South  
by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1986 One hundred and thirty perches to a Beech, thence West by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1960 Two hun-  
dred and sixty one perches to a Sugar, thence North by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1962 One hundred and thirty  
perches to the place of Beginning containing Two hundred Acres and a Fraction of six percent  
for Roads & a Hundred **MDCCCLXI**

with its appurtenances unto the said *John McKenn* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the  
said *John McKenn* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

*John McKenn* his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth

Esquire, *Vice* President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused  
the state seal to be affixed the *twenty fourth* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and eighty *six* and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
