

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

**KNOW YE,**

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Augustas Millesock private late* in the army of the *United States* there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *Stephen Loudon Assignee of the said Augustas Millesock*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland* in the tenth district of the donation lands Beginning at a Lynn tree the numbered corner and running East by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2054 Two hundred sixty one of a half perches to an Elm thence South by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2046 One hundred and thirty perches to an Elm thence West by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2056 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech thence North by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2042 One hundred and thirty perches to the place of Beginning containing Two hundred Acres and allowance of six cent for loads for numbered M<sup>MI</sup>

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Stephen Loudon his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of the said Stephen Loudon his Heirs and Assigns forever*

free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *His Excellency Benjamin Franklin* Esquire, President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the *fifth* day of *April* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
