To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

**KNOW YE,**

*Markland Lieutenant*

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John Markland* in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *John Markland*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

*In the tenth district of donation. Lands beginning at a Beech Tree the numberes  
Corner and running East by Lot No 1998 two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugar  
Tree, thence South by Lot No 1961 one hundred and thirty perches to a Buttonwood  
Tree thence West by Lot No. 1996 two hundred and sixty one perches to a spruce Tree  
thence North by Lot No 2011 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning  
Containing Two hundred acres and allowance of sixper Cent for Roads & Numbered*

with its appurtenances unto the said *John Markland* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John Markland* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

*John Markland* his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *His Excellency Benjamin Franklin* Esquire, *President of the Supreme Executive Council*, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the *Eleventh* day of *April* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the *Edventh*
