KNOW YE, That in consideration of the services rendered by *William Mackey Esquire Captain* _____ in the late army of the *United States* _____ there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *William Mackey* _____

_____ a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland* in the tenth District of Donation Lands Beginning at a *Beck* then numbered corner and running East by *Sols N^o 1907 & 1908* Three hundred and twenty five perches to a *Sugar*, thence South by *Lot N^o 123* Two hundred and sixty one perches to a *Sugar*, thence West by *Lot N^o 191* Three hundred & twenty five perches to a *Beck*, thence North by *Sol N^o 125* Two hundred and sixty one perches to the place of Beginning containing Five hundred Acres and allowance of six per cent for roads *per Summerville*

with its appurtenances unto the said *William Mackey* _____ his heirs and assigns forever: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *William Mackey* _____ his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said *William Mackey* _____ his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges.
