Donation Land

Know all Men by these presents that I William Findley Esq<sup>r</sup> of the County of Westmore  
 Land Attorney in fact of the Heirs of the within named James M. Farlane deceased duly constituted  
 by letter of Attorney bearing date the sixth day of January 1798 Have, and by these presents do remise release  
 and for ever quit claim unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania all claim and demand whatsoever for any  
 compensation which the heirs of the within named James M. Farlane deceased might have been entitled to on  
 account of their loss by reason of the tract of Donation Land within granted having fallen within the State  
 of New York, and I do surrender this Patent in compliance with the directions of an Act of General  
 Assembly passed the thirtieth day of September 1791 in consideration that the Heirs of the  
 said James M. Farlane deceased have received a grant of the lot numbered 145 of two hun-  
 dred acres of Land and allowance for roads situate in the first district of Donation Land  
 by a Patent dated this day, as an equivalent for the tract within described which has fal-  
 len in the State of New York. Witness my hand and seal the twenty seventh day of
