To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

**KNOW YE,**

That in consideration of the services rendered by George  
Tudor Esquire Major in the late army of the United States,

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said George Tudor

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland

in the 10th District of Donation Lands Beginning at a Birch and running North by lot N. 199 One hundred & ninety five perches to a Beech (the numbered corner thence East by lot N. 96 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech, thence South by lot N. 202 9 One hundred & ninety five perches to a Sugar, & thence West by lot N. 94 Two hundred & forty one perches to the place of beginning containing Three hundred Acres and allowance of six furlongs for roads & numbered XCV

with its appurtenances unto the said George Tudor his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the

said George Tudor his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

George Tudor his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and

reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof
