ise and Legally Call to full assign and set our transfer and  
do all lawful Acts for effecting the premises for all and singular  
Sums due us from Congress or the State of Pennsylvania with  
full power giving and granting unto our said Attorney, by  
these Presents our full and whole Powers, Strength and  
Authority, in and about the Premises, to have, use and take,  
all lawful Ways and Means in our Name for the Recovery  
thereof, and upon the Receipt of any such Debt, Duty or Sum  
of Money aforesaid, Receipt thereof, or other sufficient Discharges,  
for us and in our Name, to make, Seal and deliver, & generally  
all and every other Act and Acts, Things and Things, Deeds  
or Devises, in the Law whatsoever, and full and necessary to be  
done in and about the Premises, for us and in our Name,  
to do execute and perform, as fully, largely and amply, to all  
Intent and Purposes, as if we might or could do, if we were  
personally present, or all of the Matter required more Special  
Authority than is here in given, and Attorneys one or more  
under him, for the Premises aforesaid, to make and constitute,  
and again set the said to require, satisfying, allowing and
