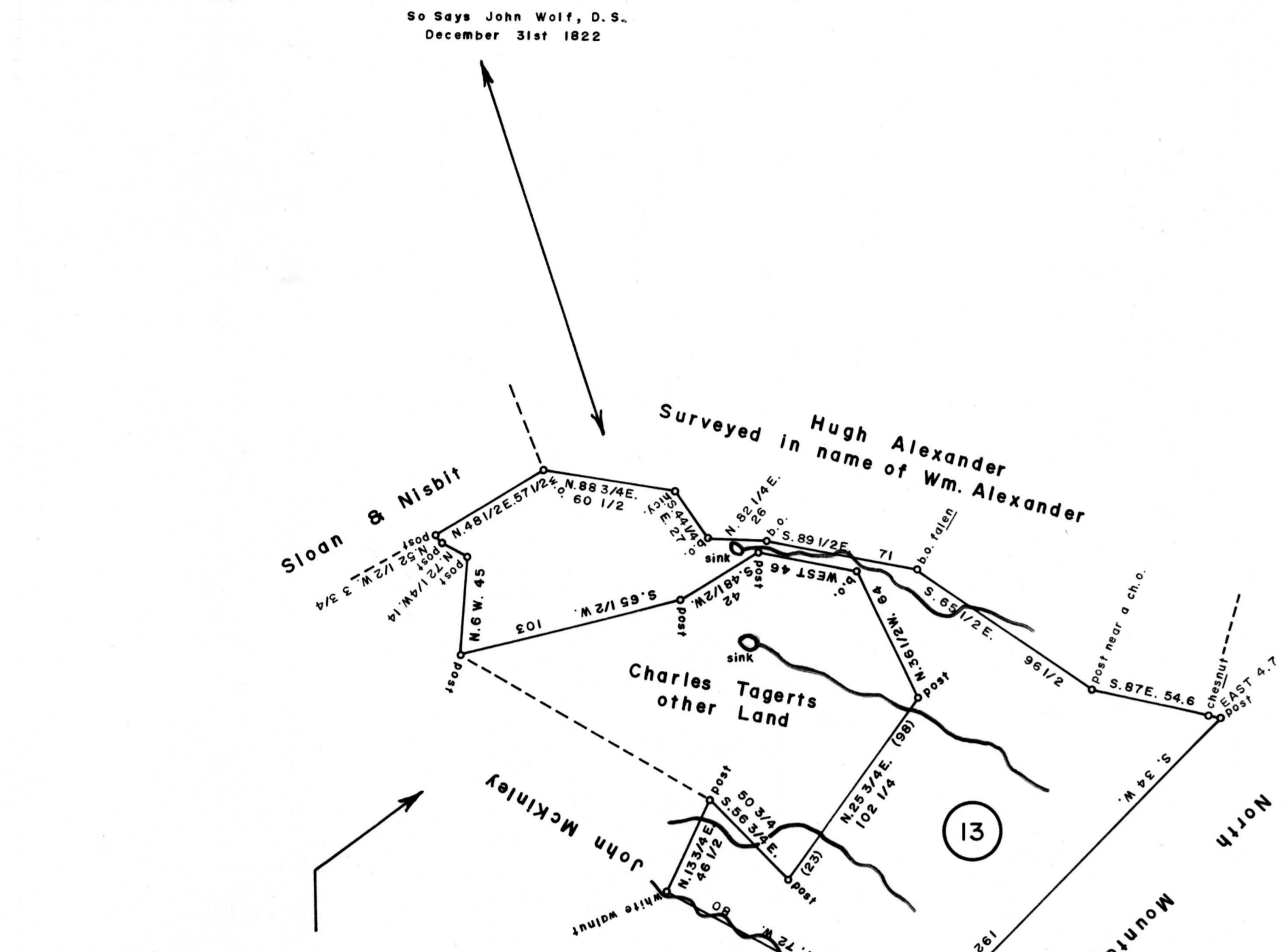
BOARD OF PROPERTY MARCH 24th 1819

PRESENT — Wm. Clark, Secretary of the Land Office
Jacob Spangler, Surveyor General

Charles Taggart by his agent John Noble states that he obtained an order of resurvey for a tract of land in Air Township, Bedford County bounded by lands of Hugh Alexander and lands of petitioner on the North Mountain. Surveyed formerly on a warrant dated 7th February 1786 for 160 Acres and on which a resurvey was executed in pursuance of the said order of resurvey on the 9th day of November 1797 and for which survey the petitioner said George King deputy of J. Woods the deputy surveyor of the district but which survey was never returned by the said George King into the office of the proper deputy surveyor. The petitioner therefore prays that the Board of Property will grant him another order of resurvey.

The Board on consideration of the prayer of the petitioner are of the opinion that it is proper to grant an order of resurvey and do hereby direct the Surveyor General to cause a resurvey to be made on said warrant provided that the same can be done without shifting the location of the same or interfering with the right of any person or to adjoining land.

RESURVEYED FOR CHARLES TAGGART THE 31st DAY OF DECEMBER 1822 (BY OR ACCORDANCE TO THE MARKS OF A RESURVEY FORMERLY MADE BY GEO. KING) IN PURSUANCE OF A WARRANT GRANTED FOR SURVEYING 160 ACRES DATED FEBRUARY 7th 1786 AND NOW BY ORDER OF THE BOARD OF PROPERTY DATED MARCH 24th 1819.



THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE FIRST PART OF THE LINE THAT FROM A S. 60° BEARS S. 69 1/2° E. 71 AND THE LINE THAT FROM A S. 60° BEARS WEST AS TO A 1/2° IN PRESENT LAND BELONGING TO THE ABOVE CHARLES TAGGART BEING PART OF A SURVEY MADE IN THE YEAR 1797 ON APPLICATION OF JOHN NUBLE.

To the honorable the Board of Property of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The petition of Guan Logan of Air Township, Bedford County respectfully thinketh that he the said Guan Logan by surveys and appearances in the Law duly had and taken is in possession of and the legal owner of a certain tract of land surveyed for John McKinley the 22nd day of March 1786 (Tract No. 19 shown in position on connected main map) on warrant dated the 7th March 1786 containing 256 acres 104 perches and allowances of adjacent and adjoining lands of Charles Taggart and Abraham Lowry situate in Air Township, Northumberland (now Bedford) County. Which said tract of land has since been patented to the John McKinley under whom your petitioner claims the lines of said survey are well marked upon the ground but the distances are longer upon the ground than represented in the survey returned to the Land Office therefore the boundaries as marked upon the ground contain considerably more land than represented in the return of survey and patent.

Your petitioner therefore prays your honors to grant him an order of resurvey upon said warrant according to the original marks upon the ground in order to make said survey and patent rectified so as to do justice to the Commonwealth and all others.

And your petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray

Guan Logan

The Board grants the prayer of the petitioner and directs the Surveyor General to cause a resurvey to be made accordingly. And directs the Secretary of the Land Office to issue a new patent to said Guan Logan on the resurvey on his relinquishing the old one to the Commonwealth.

NOTE: The result of this order is Tract No. 19-A shown above.

A CONNECTED DRAFT of twenty (20) tracts of land, which when surveyed, were situate as follows: thirteen (13) in Air Township, Bedford County; five (5) in Warren Township, Franklin County; one (1) in Air Township, Cumberland (now Bedford) County; one (1) in Air Township, Bedford (now Fulton) County. The draft has been constructed from and compared with the original drafts on file in the Bureau of Land Records, Department of Community Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Edward D. Price, Director.
