



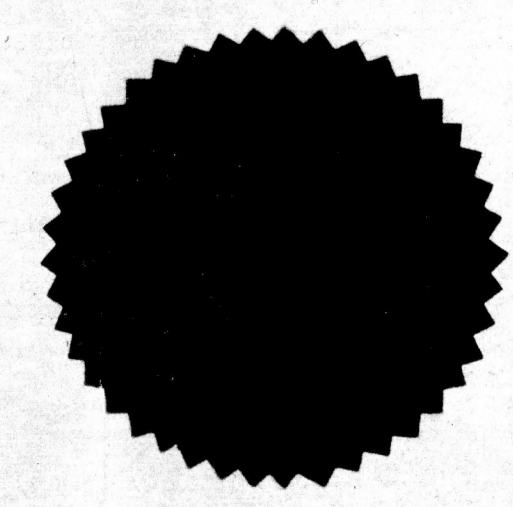

NOTE: This Area (C) shown on the Connected Draft, and shown here separately, was warranted to JOHN HANNUM on March 21, 1794, for 400 Acres and called for Nathan Sharpless on the South. The Isaac Webb warrant (Tract No. 4) was also issued on March 21, 1794 and calls JOHN HANNUM on the South. This proves that the 400 Acres warranted to JOHN HANNUM, lies between Nathan Sharpless and Isaac Webb. All three tracts were warranted on the same day, March 21, 1794, so there can be no mistake about which warrant covers this Area. However, the JOHN HANNUM warrant was never surveyed out on the ground, but the warrant gives the owner JOHN HANNUM office rights and ownership to the 400 Acres described on the warrant. Therefore, Tracts Nos. 14, 15 and 22 (infringe on this warranted Area. The warrant to JOHN HANNUM (warrant No. H—40 for 400 Acres, Bedford County) and is listed in the Bedford County Lien Docks. Lien Docket No. 4, page 29, listed under "No Survey Returned".
