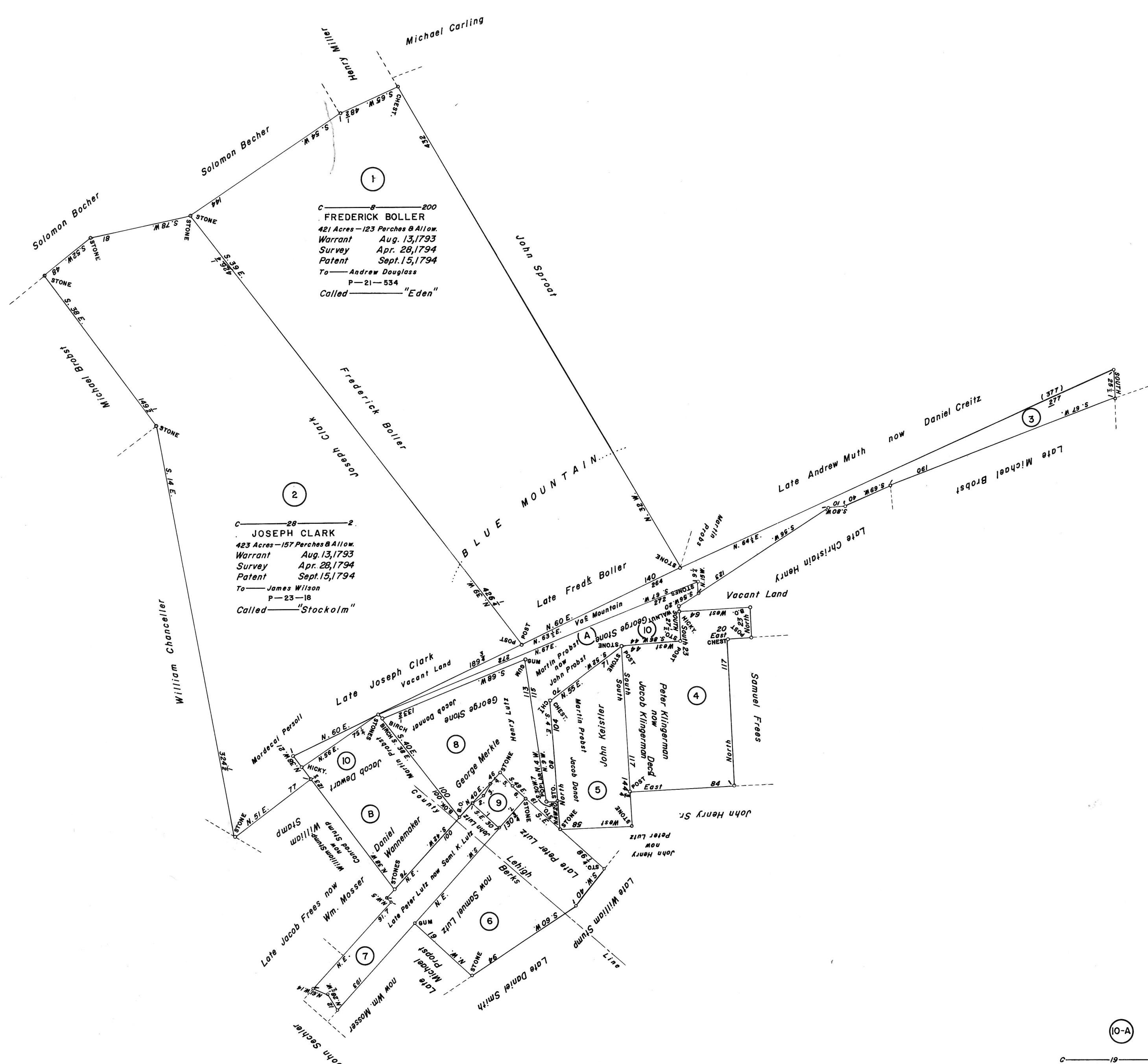

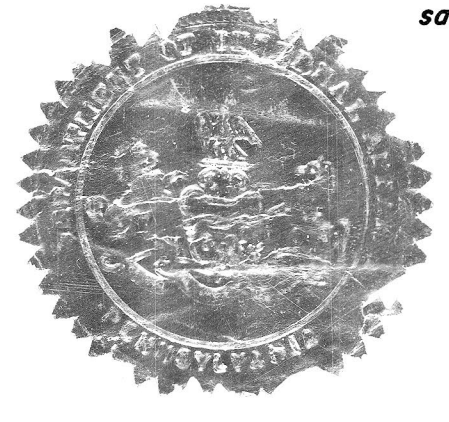

A CONNECTED DRAFT of twelve (12) tracts of land which, when surveyed, were situate as follows: three (3) in Lynn Township and two (2) in Penn and Lynn Townships, Northampton County; four (4) in Lynn Township, Northampton (now Lehigh) County; one (1) in Albany and Lynn Townships, Berks, (now Lehigh) County; and two (2) in Lynn Township, Lehigh County. The draft has been constructed and compared with the original drafts on file in the Bureau of Land Records of the Department of Internal Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Anthony G. Reese, Director.
