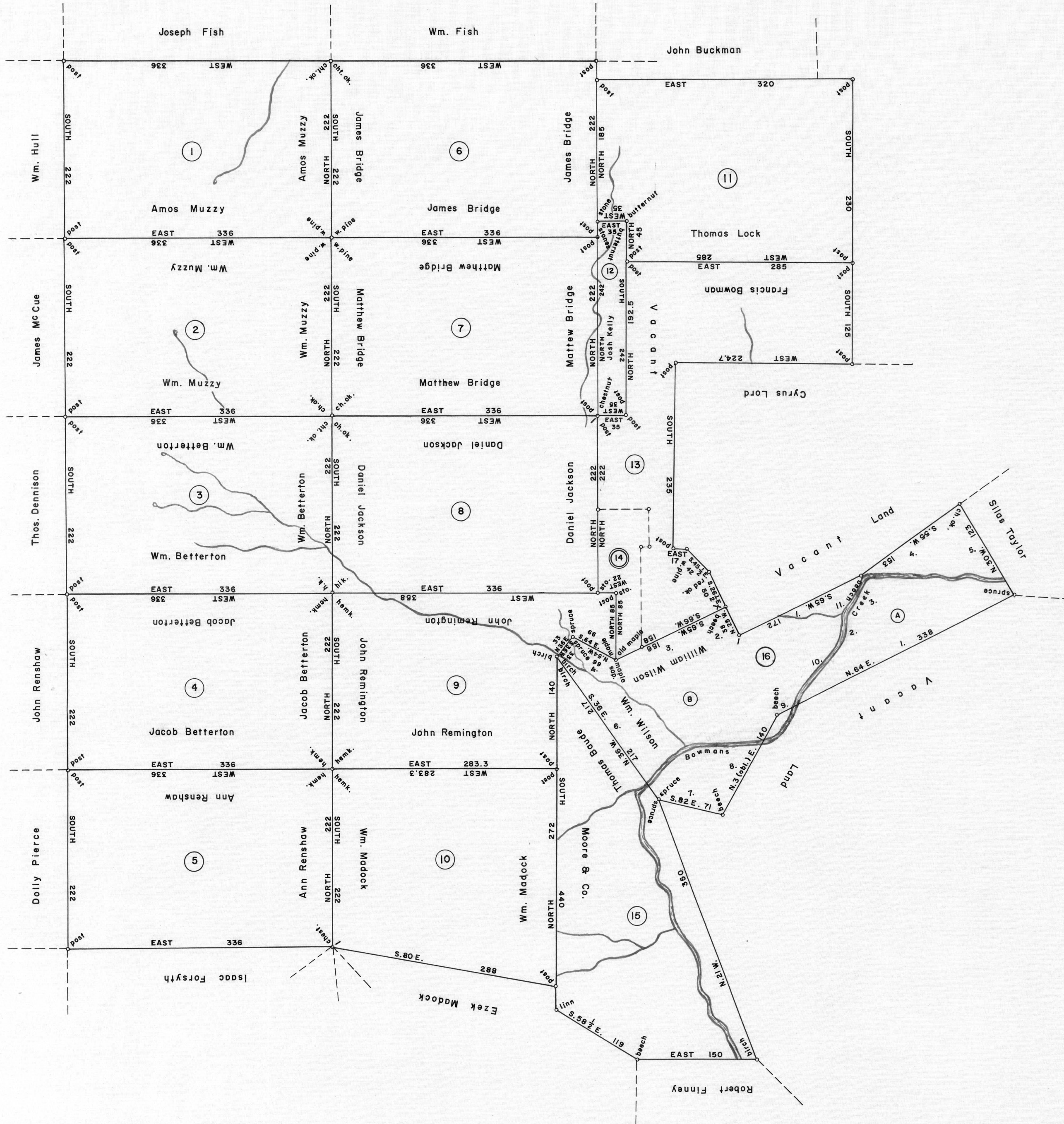

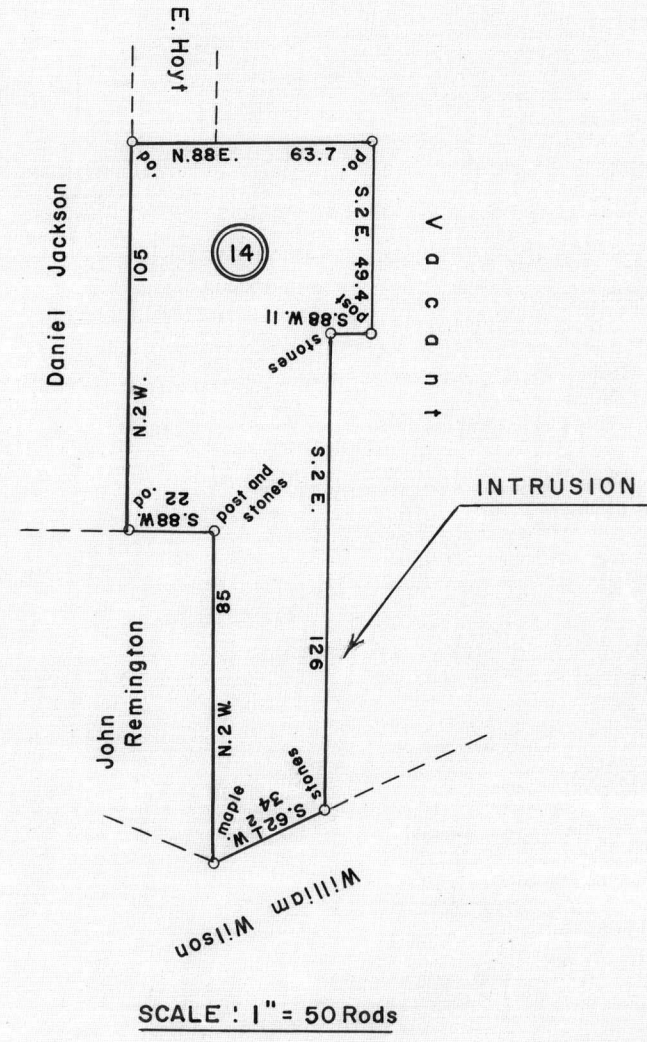

A CONNECTED DRAFT: of eighteen (18) tracts of land which, when surveyed, were situate as follows: one (1) in Wyoming (now Eaton) Township, Luzerne (now Wyoming) County; one (1) in Monroe Township, Luzerne (now Wyoming) County; two (2) in Monroe Township, Wyoming County; two (2) on Bowmans Creek, Northumberland County; one (1) on a branch of Bowmans Creek, Luzerne (now Wyoming) County; two (1) between Bowmans and Mehoopany Creeks, Luzerne County; five (5) on a branch of Bowmans Creek, Luzerne (now Wyoming) County; one (1) Eaton (now Monroe) Township, Wyoming County and four (4) in Eaton Township, Luzerne (now Wyoming) County. The draft has been constructed from and compared with original drafts on file in the Bureau of Land Records, Department of Internal Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Anthony G. Reese, Director.
