was organized at Philadelphia, Pa. in July and August 1861

Term of service, Three Years.

Mustered out of service, (except Veterans, recruits &c) August 24th 1864

at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Re-enlisted men recruits &c. organized into a battalion of 3 companies, which was increased to eight companies and transferred to the 5th Penn^a Cavalry May 8th 1865

and mustered out of service, with that organization

August 7th 1865 at Richmond Va.
