Organized at Philadelphia, Pa., February 8, 1862. Term of service three years. Portion of Regiment re-enlisted. The surplus enlisted men of this regiment were organized, April 20, 1864, into a regiment designated as the 2nd Regiment Pennsylvania Provisional Artillery, which regiment was disbanded August 26, 1864, and the men returned to the 2nd Pennsylvania Artillery. Schooley's Battery (M.) was mustered out of service June 20, 1865, at Pittsburg, Pa. The remaining portion of the regiment was mustered out of service at City Point, Va., January 29, 1866. The official list of battles in which this regiment participated not yet published.
