By direction of the Secretary of War, under his order of June 25 1862, and the complete list of the discharge of the private James S. Wainwright, Company E, 139th Pennsylvania Regiment, 20th March 1863, is amended; he left office of Captain June 4 1863; his muster is in service as 1st Lieutenant, same company and regiment as before under 2/1863, is amended to date of October 5 1863; his muster is in service as Captain, same company and regiment, July 1 1864, is amended to date June 21 1864, and he is authorized for pay in said grade during the period embraced between the foregoing dates.
