

Know all men by these presents that we Anne & Jane Bennett of the Township of Bensalem in the County of Bucks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania have manumitted & set free by these presents do for ourselves our Executors Administrators & Assigns manumitt & set free a Negro man named Cuffee Merritor aged nearly six years & six months in Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 31st day of August 1812

I do certify that Negro John the bearer hereof a black man about 27 years of age six feet & half an inch high, bow legged a large mouth flat nose and small ears a wen over the right eye and on the lashes of the left a small scar a large scar on the right foot small eyes, lips much in speaking, stout and well made - is a free man, and that the said negro John was set free by Isaac Boone by Manumission duly recorded in my office the twenty fourth day of November Anno Domini eighteen hundred and six -
